IMPACT TEAM / HOMELESS COORDINATOR

The Impact Team's goal is to enhance the quality of life in the City of Upland. The Impact Team is comprised of three police officers, a corporal, and a sergeant. One of the IMPACT team's duties is to work alongside the Homeless Coordinator to assist those experiencing homelessness by linking them to a variety of services based on the need of the individual. The Homeless Coordinator provides a wide range of linkage and follow up services.
