

AMENDMENT #1 TO AGREEMENT FOR TOWING SERVICES

This First Amendment to the original Agreement for towing services that will, from time-to-time, be requested by the Upland Police Department is made and entered into as of the 1st day of November, 2018 ("Agreement Date"), by and between the City of Upland, CA, a municipal corporation, hereinafter referred to as "City", and Steve's Towing, a California company, hereinafter referred to as "Contractor".

WHEREAS, Contractor and City entered into that certain Original Agreement for towing services that will, from time-to-time, be requested by the Upland Police Department dated November 1, 2018 ("Original Agreement"), whereby Contractor agreed to provide for towing services (as Identified in Exhibit A of the Original Agreement) through October 31, 2021 with the option to extend the contract for two one (1) year additional terms, subject to the written consent of both parties; and

WHEREAS, Contractor and City agree to amend the Agreement to extend the term for the first one year term, from November 1, 2021 through October 31, 2022 and provide for the compensation of the continuing services on the terms and conditions set forth in the Original Agreement;

THEREFORE, it is agreed by City and Contractor as follows:

1. TERM OF AGREEMENT

The term of this Amendment shall commence on November 1, 2021 and shall continue until October 31, 2022 .

2. FULL FORCE AND EFFECT

Except as modified pursuant to this amendment, all other terms and conditions of the Original Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.

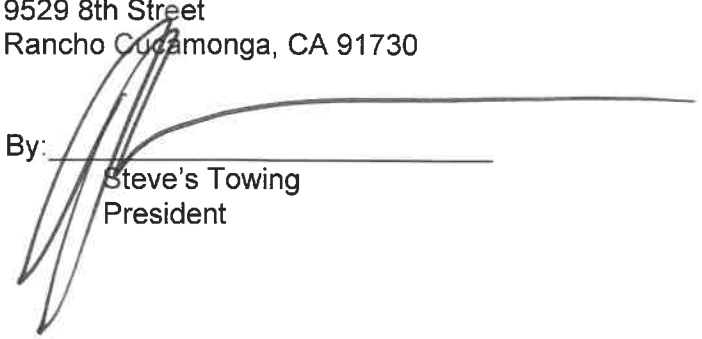
