

**AMENDMENT NO. 1 TO AGREEMENT
FOR PROFESSIONAL SERVICES WITH INTERWEST**

This Amendment No. 1 ("Amendment No. 1") is entered into as of November 4, 2024 (the "Effective Date") by and between the City of Upland, a municipal corporation ("City") and INTERWEST Consulting Group, a SAFEbuilt Company ("Consultant"), with respect to a certain Professional Services Agreement entered into by City and consultant dated September 12, 2022 ("Agreement"). City and Consultant are sometimes referred to herein individually as a "Party" and collectively as "Parties."

RECITALS

A. WHEREAS, City and Consultant entered into the Agreement for the purpose of providing plan checking and staff augmentation services.

B. WHEREAS, the Parties now desire to amend the Agreement to extend the Term from September 12, 2024 through December 31, 2024 (the "Extended Term") in order for Consultant to continue to provide the services set forth in the Agreement and to provide compensation payable to Consultant for such services.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the above recitals and the mutual covenants, conditions, and promises contained in this Amendment No. 1 and the Agreement, the Parties mutually agree as follows:

AGREEMENT

1. Incorporation of Recitals. The recitals listed above are true and correct and are hereby incorporated herein by this reference.

2. Compensation Commencing September 12, 2024. Notwithstanding any provision in Section 2 of the Agreement to the contrary, commencing September 12, 2024 and through the end of the Extended Term, and for the services rendered by Consultant to City during the Extended Term, the compensation due Consultant shall not exceed the sum of \$ 27,500.

3. Term Commencing September 12, 2024. Notwithstanding any provision in Section 5 of the Agreement to the contrary, the Term of the Agreement shall be extended from September 12, 2024, through December 31, 2024, unless sooner terminated pursuant to the provisions of the Agreement.

4. Reaffirmation of Terms of Agreement. Except as amended by this Amendment No. 1, all the terms and provisions of the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect for the Extended Term.

5. Electronic Transmission. A manually signed copy of this Amendment No. 1 which is transmitted by facsimile, email or other means of electronic transmission shall be deemed to have the same legal effect as delivery of an original executed copy of this Amendment No. 1 for all purposes. This Amendment No. 1 may be signed using an electronic signature.

6. Counterparts. This Amendment No. 1 may be signed in counterparts, each of which shall constitute an original.
