K-9 Rudy Retires after 8.5 years of active service from Upland PD Patrol and Narcotics Detection K-9 (59.5 dog years)!

- ❖ Rudy is the longest serving police dog in Upland Police Department history!
- ❖ Rudy & partner responded to over 11,000 calls for service!

During his lifetime tenure, Rudy was instrumental in the seizure of 89,209 grams of illegal narcotics with a street value of appx. \$13 per gram – \$1,159,717 – off the streets!

Rudy's nose also allowed the seizure of 1.3 million

dollars in cash (narcotics related). His amazing ability led to 163 direct arrests of suspects for narcotics violations; he recovered 6 discarded guns, located a knife related to a homicide and located a large metal pipe used in a homicide which would not have been recovered without a K-9. His skills extended to assisting in finding missing persons using his nose to track human odor.



On patrol calls, he responded to burglary alarms, yard to yard searches, and vehicle pursuits. Rudy had countless calls related to violent subjects attempting to fight police or flee. As a de-escalation tool, Rudy led to the surrender of 109 suspects – meaning there was no force needed to affect a safe arrest. Rudy physically apprehended 28 felony suspects who refused to surrender (lying in wait hiding from officers or actively fleeing).

Rudy is the 1st UPD K-9 to be integrated with the Upland SWAT team and he assisted in 44 SWAT missions. He also assisted on special ops with the FBI, DEA, US Marshall, Cal DOJ Narcotics enforcement bureau, and other special ops narcotics task force teams in SoCal.

He will retire at the home of his handler, Corporal Quinn Hanley who stated: "It's impossible to quantify the man hours saved and lives of officers and even the lives of suspects that were saved, simply by Rudy being in the streets when he was needed. He has earned the respect of his fellow officers and deserves a long and fulfilling retirement."



Petey, shown left with his handler Detective Nick Alvarran, will be continuing to serve Upland citizens as a loyal K-9. Petey has similar impressive stats and accomplishments in suspect surrenders, service, and narcotics detection (93 pounds of seized narcotics in 2024)!

Our goal is to raise funds to purchase and train a new dog to replace Rudy and restore our two K-9 dog coverage for all 7 days a week. That is very important as crime does not take a day off.
