Dear City of Upland Business Owner,

The City of Upland has partnered with the California State Franchise Tax Board Interagency Intercept Collections Program (IICP) to collect delinquent business license taxes and fees owed to the City of Upland. Effective June 2025, all unpaid business license taxes, penalty fees and administrative citation fees will be submitted to IICP. IICP will collect the outstanding amounts through garnishments of tax refunds, lottery winnings and unclaimed property.

If your City of Upland business license tax account has a delinquent balance due, your account will be submitted to IICP for collection. The California Franchise Tax Board does not have the ability to remove or modify any debt amount submitted for delinquent accounts. You must contact the City of Upland to resolve a delinquent business license tax account and have it removed from the IICP.
